Eligibility Criteria

- You must be aged 14-24 to apply to become a Youth Ambassador
- You must be based in the UK, ideally in the North West of England

Additional information

- All Savera UK volunteers including Savera UK Youth, must comply with relevant Savera UK policies such as health and safety, data protection, safeguarding and code of conduct
- Savera UK will cover all reasonable expenses incurred by volunteers in relation to and when carrying out volunteer responsibilities for Savera UK
- Any volunteers under the age of 18 will need parent or guardian consent to apply

- We particularly encourage applications from young people with lived experience of 'honour'-based abuse and harmful practices such as forced marriage, female genital mutilation (FGM) and conversion therapy
