- Take responsibility for a chosen area of interest (e.g., marketing & communications, lobbying & campaigning, education etc.)
- Lead on projects, exhibitions, and campaigns that make a difference
- Attend events and school activities when needed (DBS required)
- Contribute regularly to the role, including attending monthly meetings
- Be an advocate and positive role model for Savera UK Youth Collective
- Be positive, proactive, and ready to contribute

What you can expect from us

- All Youth Collective Board Members will receive an induction session
- Training and professional development opportunities, such as:
 - Networking events
 - 'Honour'-based abuse and harmful practices training with the Savera UK team
 - Communications and Public Relations training with Savera UK team
 - Any other relevant training such as leadership, campaigning, public speaking
- You'll have access to a range of resources and guidance from the Savera UK team
- We will help you connect with like-minded individuals and professionals
- We are committed to creating an inclusive environment and encourage applications from all backgrounds, abilities, and identities

Eligibility Criteria

- You must be aged 16-24 to apply to become a Youth Collective Board Member
- You must be based in the UK, ideally in the North West of England

Additional information

- All Savera UK volunteers including Savera UK Youth must comply with relevant Savera UK policies such as health and safety, data protection, safeguarding and code of conduct
- Savera UK will cover all reasonable expenses incurred by volunteers in relation to and when carrying out volunteer responsibilities for Savera UK
- Any volunteers under the age of 18 will need parent or guardian consent to apply
- We particularly encourage applications from young people with lived experience of 'honour'-based abuse and harmful practices such as forced marriage, female genital mutilation (FGM) and conversion therapy
